Selection Criteria: Proposals will first undergo a mechanical review for format and adherence to the submission guidelines. The submission guidelines are included on the submission form. Proposals that do not follow the guidelines will be returned without review. After the mechanical review, all proposals will be reviewed by each member of the Programming Committee for applicability, content, and potential benefit to conference attendees.
