

Senator Duties

The elected Student Senators for the Student Government Association are the deciding body on legislature as stated in the Constitution. Representing the student body with the voice and opinion as well as other duties is required to maintain this elected office.

ATTENDANCE

- Senators are required to attend all scheduled meetings unless previously excused by the president of the senate (VPLA).
- The accumulation of three unexcused absences per semester or six office hours will result in the loss of the seat.

ELECTIONS

- Senators must help with all Troy University elections. As stated in the constitution, two senators must be at the voting polls at all times. Each senator will have designated time to work the election.

OFFICE HOURS

- All senators are required to work one hour of service to the SGA office weekly, performing all duties assigned by committees or by the task listed on the board.

By accepting the elected office of senator, you must also be available daily to serve and communicate with the students you represent. Senators are also involved in the various activities on campus and volunteer their time to help aid and represent the students as well as the Troy University System.
