

HOMECOMING COURT/QUEEN APPLICATION

Troy University main campus students may be nominated for Homecoming Queen by only student organizations on campus. A nomination fee of \$15 per candidate must be paid when application is turned in. Candidates must have a Troy University minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, have completed 30 hours at Troy University, and be in good standing with the university. This form must be turned in to the SGA office by 4:00 on **Thursday, October 1, 2009**. Nominees must schedule an appointment when submitting an application to get her picture taken. If a group submits an application for a candidate, they are responsible for getting the candidates to come to the SGA office to schedule an appointment. Elections for the Homecoming Court will be held October 6, 2009. The Court will be announced the same night at the Middle Tennessee Football game. The Queen Election (out of the Court) will be held Wednesday October 14, 2009. The Queen will be announced during Halftime at the Troy University Homecoming game on October 24, 2009.

****Pictures will be taken of each of the candidates on Friday, October 2, 2009, so please sign up in the SGA office for a picture time upon dropping off your application. These are the pictures that are to go on the ballot for Election Day. If your picture is not taken the Student Government Association will not be liable. Also, the organization nominating the candidate must submit a 200 word or less document explaining why their candidate is deserving of representing Troy University on the 2009 Homecoming Court to Clerk Liz Dowe at sgavote@troy.edu by **Thursday, October 1, 2009 by 4 pm**.**
